The <u>Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender (LGBT) Caucus of the APHA</u> joined an amicus brief in *Fulcher v. Secretary of Veterans Affairs*, which challenged the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs' refusal to engage in rulemaking to reconsider its ban on providing transgender-related surgery to veterans.
